

Greening the DLSPH: Terms of Reference

1. The DLSPH Greening Work Group will be comprised of members of faculty, staff and students, as well as a representative from the Sustainability Office.
2. The position of Chair person will rotate.
3. One or two year terms for committee members, renewable.
4. The committee will meet bi-monthly or more often as needed.
5. The mandate of the DLSPH Greening Work Group will consult widely, develop, implement and evaluate the DLSPH Environmental Plan.
6. The Committee will seek to influence behaviours, resources, policies of the School.
7. Targets will be set for each year, and approved at a School meeting. These targets will be supported by a work plan.
8. Progress reports will be submitted at the Departmental meeting once a year.
9. The DLSPH Environmental Plan is a living document, which is intended to record successes, new targets, progress, and new ambitious future actions.
10. Sub-groups may be struck to work on specific projects. These may be comprised of members and/or non-members.
